<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• minimum of 120 total credits</li> <li>• minimum of 30 credits at IU South Bend for campus residency</li> <li>• maximum of 60 community college credits applied to bachelor degree</li> <li>• minimum 30 credits at the 300-400-level</li> <li>• minimum 12 credits in major at 300-400 level taught by IUSB faculty</li> <li>• 'C' average (2.0) in the major and the minor and cumulative GPA (2.0)</li> </ul>

To be awarded STGEC, one must complete: Written Communication, Speaking & Listening, Quantitative Reasoning, Scientific Ways of Knowing, Social & Behavioral Ways of Knowing, Humanistic & Artistic Ways of Knowing, plus select classes to reach 30 credits and earn 2.0 gpa.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• See bottom of IUSB unofficial transcript. Must be 'Report Type': <i>Student Program Transcript</i></li><li>• Also found in the transcript posted in "AAR + Transcript" and at top of "Advising Records"</li></ul>
<b>Need to know:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If the major has grade requirement for waived Gen Ed, student must complete the requirement.</li><li>• If a major/minor requirement overlaps a waived Gen Ed, student must complete the requirement.</li><li>• If waived Gen Ed requirement is a prerequisite course, student must complete the requirement.</li></ul>
