**Declaring a Major in German:**

To formally declare a major in German, you will either need to fill out this [online form](#) or see the Student Services Administrative Assistant Paul Foltz in DW 3300B (located on the Bridge on Wiekamp Hall). Please be sure to have your 10-digit student ID number with you. This process is relatively quick and only takes a few minutes. When you arrive, please tell Paul that you would like to declare a major in German and he will direct you to the appropriate form. Once you complete this process, Paul will update your student record and send the update to the department so Dr. Luppés can be formally assigned as your academic advisor.
